Approval of Warm Water System: AVG Thermostatic Mixing Valve Models 15 & 20

Thank you for your application for the AVG Thermostatic Mixing Valve Models 15 & 20 which was submitted to the NSW Department of Health pursuant to the requirements of the Public Health (Microbial Control) Regulation, 2000, Clause 7(2) for approval as a warm water system of a kind which automatically produces warm water for ablution purposes in a health care facility.

Your application has been assessed by NSW Health and subsequently **approved** by the Director-General's delegate. The approval is subject to the ongoing compliance with the NSW Health Department Policy Directive PD2005_344 – "Water - Requirements for the Provision of Cold and Heated Water," and any superseding document of the same title in accordance with clause 13 of the Regulation. Alterations and modifications to the warm water systems may affect the approval and therefore the details of any alteration or modification must be submitted to NSW Health for consideration.
